



Accessing your Microsoft® SharePoint® 2010 site online from a mobile device lets you enjoy productivity and collaboration benefits, even when you are away from the office. Use your mobile device to connect to SharePoint 2010 to access information, collaborate with colleagues view updated site content and stay connected.

The mobile version of a site lets you see only some elements of a site that you would see in the desktop version, such as lists, libraries, the search feature and My Site. The user-interface is simple and intuitive so you can start using your site right away. The key tasks that the mobile version offers are viewing items in lists and libraries and opening Office documents from the site.

To access a SharePoint site with your web-enabled phone:

You can access your site with a Windows phone by opening the phone's web browser and entering the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) of your SharePoint site. If you are using a non-Windows phone, you can enter the URL in the browser or, to see an optimized mobile view, you can just append /?Mobile=1 to the URL. For example, if your site is called http://fabrikam.com, then the mobile version of the URL would be http://fabrikam.com/?Mobile=1.
